

Fence Maintenance Checklist Keep Your Fence Strong Year-Round in North Texas

Spring	Summer
Inspect all fence posts for leaning or movement	Examine boards for warping or cracking from sun exposure
Check for rot, mold, or insect damage	Check stain/sealant for fading or peeling
Tighten or replace loose screws and hardware	Trim overgrown grass, shrubs, and vines away from fence line
Clean debris and leaves from fence base	Water fence base during drought to minimize ground cracking
Rinse fence with hose only— power washing can scar wood.	Remove nests, cobwebs, and signs of pests
Fall Fall	Winter
Fall Apply or refresh wood stain or sealant as needed	Winter Inspect fence after storms for wind or ice damage
Apply or refresh wood stain or	Inspect fence after storms for
